CAB[®] Cook-Off

One of the most notable contests at the National Junior Angus Show - this contest facilitates communication skills, cooking skills and state comradery as you compete as a state group. There are 3 different categories: roast, steak and other beef. The team is asked to prepare a dish based on one of the three categories using Certified Angus Beef[®].



DETAILS

Once prepared, the team must perform a skit or demonstration promoting CAB[®]. The team will be judged on their recipe (taste), and their showmanship skills (skit/demonstration). There will also be an overall winner of each category.

Champion Int. Steak team wins Pat Grote LEAD Award and all members awarded scholarship to attend LEAD. Top team from all age divisions and categories wins Black Kettle Award.
