We would like to take this opportunity to invite you to participate in the 38<sup>th</sup> annual Atlantic National ROV Super Point and Junior Regional Preview Show. The show will be held at the Maryland State Fairgrounds (2200 York Rd, Timonium, MD 21093). **ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ONLINE.** The information can be found on the American Angus Association website. Make sure that you read all of the information in regard to the show. Please make sure that whoever is attending the show has also read all of the rules, regulations and show information.

**Remember that any recipients brought with ET calves must have health papers!**

Bedding is tan bark which is included in your entry fee. **No white shavings allowed by request of our tanbark provider.**

**Make sure you bring a wheelbarrow!** No trash in the manure and no manure in the trash barrels. **GLASS BOTTLES AREN'T ALLOWED IN THE BARN.** We appreciate your cooperation in these important matters.

No cattle will be permitted on the fairgrounds prior to **Wednesday May 22<sup>nd</sup> – 8:00 a.m.** Cattle tie outs in designated areas only. Anyone not following this rule will be charged an additional clean up fee. Be sure to check with show management.

Upon your arrival, please check with show management in regards to your stalling space. The stalls will be marked with your farm or exhibitor name. Tack space is provided for you based on the number of entries. **PLEASE NOTE: Should you desire to stall near or with another exhibitor, please inform us when you submit your entries. Once the stalling has been completed it can't be changed!**

Junior exhibitors who wish to leave after the junior show may do so after receiving permission from the show management. If you leave without receiving permission from the show management. If you leave without receiving permission, you will forfeit your premiums. We encourage all junior exhibitors to participate in the open show as well. This would be a very rewarding experience. Open show exhibitors are dismissed after the supreme champion is announced.
